SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Introduction

This uniform policy aims to provide parents and students with a clear and common understanding of what is required in terms of the school uniform.

School uniform is compulsory and can be purchased at the school. All students, from Kindergarten to Secondary, are required to wear the designated school uniform whilst on school premises and when attending official school activities outside of the school, during and after school hours.

Policy Statement

A school uniform encourages a sense of belonging and provides a visible identity within the Generations International School Community.

Our uniform reflects the distinctive nature of Generations International School. Our school colors are light blue, turquoise, and yellow. The school logo featured on the polo shirt consists of a lighthouse and a G, the first symbolizing the East meeting the West, and the second symbolizing the encounter of Generations, which are part of the mission and vision of the school.

The logo also carries the motto "Discoveries Enlighten Life" (Lighthouse, light).

There is also a yellow bucket hat for kindergarten and a cap for the other grades that are to be worn as part of school uniform.

Aims

Students will:

- Wear the **full school uniform** to school every day.
- Wear the prescribed school hat all year round (especially when outside the school).

Parents are expected to:

- Support the school in ensuring students wear the correct uniform.
- Label all the items with the student's name for easy identification.

Generations International School will:

- Encourage students to always wear the correct uniform.
- Provide a page on its website for the uniform request.

Violation of the dress code may result in school staff contacting the Guardian/Parent, confiscating the item, or even sending the student home to change clothes.

All clothing items must be labeled with the student's first and last name to safeguard possible uniform exchanges between children.

In specific situations of excessive cold, the School will inform families in advance about the possibility of bringing other clothing items.


Generations International School Uniform

Summer and winter uniforms are interchangeable at Generations School. Parental discretion is required whether choosing, for example, long or short sleeves, shorts, skorts or pants.

Kindergarten, Primary and Secondary are identified by their T-shirt and Poloshirt (except kindergarten).

The T-shirt from Kindergarten is a white T-shirt without yellow lines on the side.

KINDERGARTEN UNIFORM

Every day, the students must wear a uniform consisting of:

- ✓ Generations T-shirt (short or long sleeves)
- √ Generations Sport Shorts or Pants
- ✓ Generations Short and Long Socks
- √ Generations Backpack
- ✓ White sneakers (without colorful laces, letters or decorative elements)*

On the first day of each week, the students should bring to school, in the Generations bag, the following items:

- ✓ Generations Bib.
- ✓ Generations Yellow Hat
- ✓ Generations Duvet
- ✓ Generations Sheet
- √ Generations Pillowcase
- ✓ Pillow*

On the last day of each week, the students will take the bag with their belongings back home to be properly sanitized.

Every day, students must bring their Generations backpack with their personal belongings, all duly identified. This backpack must also contain a complete, properly washed set of uniform (including underwear).

Other items to be considered:

- ✓ Generations Bomber or Sport jackets
- ✓ Generations Yellow Fleece for the Bomber (for colder days)

On the first day of school, students should bring a pair of shoes to be worn indoors. This pair will remain at the school throughout the Academic Year.

PRIMARY & SECONDARY UNIFORM

Every day, except when there are P.E. classes, students must wear a uniform consisting of:

- ✓ Generations Polo-shirt (short or long sleeves)
- ✓ Generations Shorts, Skorts or Pants
- ✓ Generations Short or Long Socks
- √ Generations Backpack**
- ✓ White sneakers (without colorful laces, letters or decorative elements)*

P.E. Uniform

- ✓ Generations T-shirt with one yellow line (short or long sleeves)
- ✓ Generations Sport Shorts or Pants
- ✓ Generations Sport Jacket
- ✓ Generations Short or Long Socks
- ✓ White sneakers (without colorful laces, letters or decorative elements)*

On the last day of each week, the students will take the cap and school's apron back home to be properly sanitized for use in the following week.

Other items to be considered:

- ✓ Generations Bomber
- ✓ Generations Yellow Fleece for the Bomber (for colder days)

At Generations, makeup, hair color and nail polish must be soft, subtle and have a natural effect. Hair accessories should be as simple and discreet as possible.

Earrings and jewelry must not present any risk to the health of our students.

Implementation

In the event of a student arriving at school, not in full uniform, a teacher or any other staff member will provide a verbal reminder of our policy and present the student with a 'Uniform Notice'. Upon the second notice, the student will be sent home to change.

<u>Exceptional Circumstances</u>: The school recognizes that occasionally, due to family reasons, a child may come to school out of uniform. On these occasions parents should provide a note to the class teacher. The Principal may also approve special occasions where uniforms are not required to be worn.

Lost and Found

All goods or articles found within the school premises will be sent to the "Lost and Found" section located on the ground floor of the school, at the Reception Desk.
